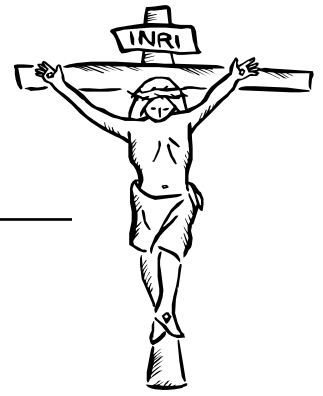

Children's Liturgy of the Word

Children's Liturgy of the Word is an opportunity for young children to attend Mass with their parents while still receiving education that is age-appropriate. During the "Liturgy of the Word" (readings, homily, creed, and intercessions) young children will gather in the Fellowship Hall for a lesson. Prior to the First Reading, Fr. Balluff will invite these children to join their catechist in the Fellowship Hall. They will return to their parents during the offertory song.

- This program at St. Boniface is available to children ages 3 and up who have not yet received First Communion. Children in grades 1&2 may attend Children's Liturgy of the Word *in addition* to their Wednesday Faith Formation classes.
- There is no fee for Children's Liturgy of the Word and registration is not required.
- Children's Liturgy of the Word will be held during the Sunday 10:30 am Mass at St. Boniface each week beginning on Sunday, October 3rd.

Sacrament Preparation

First Reconciliation & First Communion

The second grade curriculum focuses on preparing students for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Communion.

A **parent meeting** will be held on Wednesday, October 6th at 5:15 pm in the school building to discuss preparations for both sacraments.

First Reconciliation

Our Parent/Child Gathering is on Saturday, December 4th at 10:00 am in the school.
The Celebration of First Reconciliation is on Saturday, January 22nd at 11:00 am in the Church.

First Communion

Our Parent/Child Gathering is on Saturday, February 19th at 10:00 am in the school.
Our Parent/Child First Communion Practice is on Wednesday, April 27th at 5:15 pm in the Church.
The Celebration of First Communion is on Sunday, May 1st at 10:30 am Mass.

Confirmation Preparation Program

The St. Boniface Confirmation Preparation Program is designed as a two year program, completed during the 9th & 10th grades. Classes are held on Wednesday evenings from 7:00-8:15. Each year includes class sessions, service projects, and other faith events. Students also attend a weekend or day Confirmation preparation retreat at some point during their preparation.

Students are expected to attend all classroom sessions, service projects, retreats, and fulfill their Sunday (or Saturday night) and Holy Day obligations for Holy Mass.

A **parent/student meeting** will be held on Wednesday, September 15th at 7:00 pm in the Fellowship Hall. All 9th & 10th grade students are expected to attend with at least one parent.

The celebration of **Confirmation** will take place on Saturday, April 9th at 10:00 am at the Basilica of St. Mary in Minneapolis.

The parish "**Welcoming Mass**" will be held for the newly confirmed students on Sunday, April 10th at the 10:30 am Mass.

SACRAMENT PREPARATION

General Information

Tuition:

In order to provide text books and other materials for our Faith Formation program, we charge a small fee per student. Parishioners of St. Boniface pay \$50.00 per student; non-parishioners pay \$75.00 per student with \$150.00 cap per family.

Severe Weather:

If the local school districts have early dismissal or are closed due to the weather, St. Boniface Faith Formation classes will also be canceled. If schools are not closed but there are severe weather changes during the day, we will make every attempt to contact schools to make an announcement of our class cancellation. If it is too late to make that announcement, an attempt will be made to contact each home with the information. If you question whether or not class will be held, please call the Faith Formation office at 446-1224. If we do not cancel, please use your own judgment.

Attendance:

Continuing Christian development requires students to attend classes regularly at all grade levels. If your child will be absent, you must inform the Faith Formation office prior to class. Students will not be permitted to leave class early without permission from their parents or guardians.

Communication:

Please watch the Sunday bulletin and/or the parish website for Faith Formation updates! Flyers and letters will be sent home with your student as needed.

Criminal History Background Checks:

Your child's safety is of the utmost importance to us. All employees as well as all school volunteers who have regular or unsupervised contact with minors are subject to criminal background checks and must attend a VIRTUS Training Session and sign the volunteer code of conduct.

Student Participation:

The study of the Catholic faith is about building a relationship— coming to know and love the Person of Jesus Christ. Like any relationship, effort must be put forth by both people. The following qualities will help our students grow in this relationship with Christ and will help our catechists maintain a positive learning environment for all of our students:

- A **willingness** to learn, participate, and grow in their faith
- A **great respect** for the rights of others and their property, with a particular respect for their catechists
- An **attentive responsibility** for one's work and actions
 - ⇒ Food and drink are not allowed on a regular basis. Students should ask their catechist's permission to bring food and drink into the classroom.
 - ⇒ Toys, games, electronic devices, ipods, cell phones, and the like are NOT allowed in the classroom. *Parents must call Faith Formation office if you need to get a hold of your child(ren) during class.
 - ⇒ Students should thoroughly complete any homework assignments given by their catechists.

Discipline Policy:

If a student fails to follow the rules outlined above, or other rules implemented by his/her catechist, he/she will be asked to leave the classroom. This discipline violation will be discussed by the student, catechists, and director. Upon a second violation, both the student's parents and Fr. Balluff will be notified. Upon a third violation, there will be a meeting with Fr. Balluff, the student and his/her parents to draw up a probation contract.
